Morah Tziri

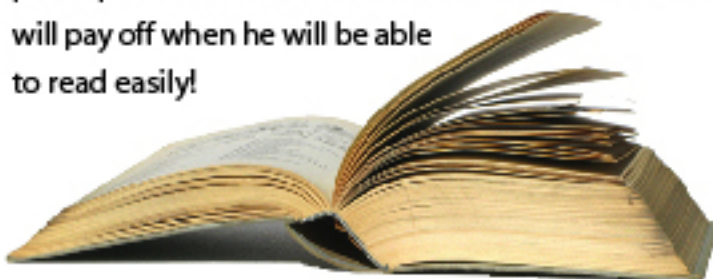


Yehuda feels very proud of himself. He is doing an amazing job at reading and is already up to book #3! Keep up the great work Yehuda!
